





CASTE IN INSTITUTIONS DEVOTED TO THE EDUCATION OF THE COLORED RACE.

By the educational statistics of the last census there were 124 institutions for the instruction of the colored race, having an enrolment of 15,404 students, requiring 576 instructors.

The greater number of institutions devoted exclusively to Negro education are situated in the South. The larger portion of the work has been and still is carried on by denominational enterprise. Possibly the most important part of the work has been under the supervision of the American Missionary Association, the Presbyterian Board of Missions for Freedmen, and the Freedmen's Aid Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church.

It is a well known fact that a few of these institutions employ colored men in their Faculties; and we have endeavored to secure information as to the actual percentage of colored persons serving as Professors in institutions, but have failed to receive a reply to our queries.

Wonder Woman

My husband bought me a comic book while we were on vacation. It was a copy of "Wonder Woman". Remember Wonder Woman? She was sort of the female equivalent of Superman, born during World War II when the country was courting Rosie the Riveter and trying to change the image of women (in women's own minds) from stay-at-home to conquer-the-world. Created by an enterprising guy named Charlie Moulton, Wonder Woman was, to be blunt about it, a comic illustrator's patriotic contribution to the war effort against the Nazis. The original story introducing Wonder Woman makes this point clear: It describes how she is chosen as the strongest and wisest Amazon to go to America, "The last citadel of democracy, and of equal rights for women" (oh yeah? sez I) to help fight "the forces of hate and oppression".

Nevertheless, she was marvelous, and I loved with the passion of a true (albeit then unknowing) feminist every frame of every story. But Wonder Woman today--well, just let me show you how far we've come, baby. Wonder Woman today, in her disguise as Diana Prince (notice the name!) is the happy proprietor of--- a boutique. She dresses mod and no longer wears her magic wrist bands (which, by the way, the original story explained were worn by all Amazons as an eternal reminder that they had once been taken into slavery by men and must therefore forever after keep aloof from them.) Gone, too, are her magic lasso and magic airplane. Her weapons now are limited to a quick mind and knowledge of karate. Ah, yes, she also has a pilot's license. This might sound like an effort to make her more believable, but all it actually does is divest her of her former super-human powers. She is now clearly human.


